Classic Aria was bred by Angela Tiede at Clarkefield, Victoria. She was born on 9 September 2011 and started under saddle in 2015.

Aria's mother is Classic Tipperary, a foundation Waler mare from Cordillo Downs Station (sire and dam unknown). Foundation Walers were rescued from the mid 1980s from old Waler breeding stations known to have no modern breed of horse introduced since 1948, the last year of the Waler export trade.

Aria's father is Classic Ezekiel, a Waler stallion bred by Ben & Jacqui Kindblad and born at Clarkefield, from foundation Waler mare Newhaven Pearl (Newhaven Station, northwest of Alice Springs) and foundation Waler stallion Classic Dardanelle (Cordillo Downs Station, southeast of Birdsville).

Classic Aria is a beautiful girl, a fine boned mare running true to the old Thoroughbred type used on Cordillo Downs to breed officer's horses. She is smart and super sensitive, her at times wild nature a legacy of being the last foal from a wild mare.

Aria has been to some adult riding and Working Equitation rallies, and is still very much a work in progress. She loves to be challenged with new and interesting things, as she tends to try and anticipate if worked the same way too regularly. Her deeply entrenched flight instinct can take over if her focus is not retained at all times, and she is nifty and quick on her feet. Aria is a strong willed girl who can teach her riders and handlers a great deal, she will do anything for you if she feels safe and respected.
